



# Cyberforce Security: Risk and Mitigation

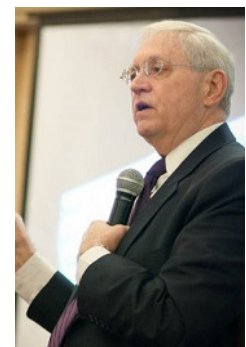
The one-day course will provide a basic-level of understanding of cybersecurity, risks, and related issues for C-level executives to raise awareness of their responsibilities under the Sarbanes-Oxley Act. This course focuses on vulnerabilities, the inevitability of cyberattacks, and the corporate and legal responsibilities that senior officers must manage to mitigate the risk.

## Three Main Topics Covered:

- Introduction to cybersecurity, including definitions and the technical foundation of why systems cannot be made completely secure
- Introduction to historical and current threats, including an analysis of weapons, actors and motivations spread across cybercrime, cyberespionage and cyberwarfare.
- Risk management which addresses corporate cyber responsibility and risk, including assessing cyber value and risk, and quantifying that risk so it can be managed.
